Souper Bowl of Caring Offering: For most of the last 14 years, youth in the Gary-Rindal Parish (and the last two years including Confirmation Students from Immanuel/Calvary/Our Savior's) have raised funds to Tackle Hunger by taking an offering during Worship the day of the Big Game.

Last year, we as a joint parish raised over \$614 to donate, split between 2 local food shelves. This year, we are upping the ante even more. We will split donations between 3 local food shelves (hosted at Grace Lutheran in Erskine, Helping Hands in Mahnomen, and Good Samaritan in Twin Valley) so that we can help folks in our entire mission field who are struggling with food insecurity.

This year our youth will be asking for monetary donations AND donations of shelf stable food at the end of Worship at all of our service locations on Sunday, February 12. Leaders of the food shelves sent the following list of items that are needed: Cereal, Canned soup, Spaghetti sauce, Crackers, Pancake mix, Syrup, Canned fruit, Pudding/Jello cups, Jelly, Peanut butter, Cake mix and frosting.

Folks are invited to wear their favorite jersey to Worship that day, in support of this mission and your favorite team. (If you would like to donate, but won't be in Worship on Feb. 12, please contact Katie to set up an offering pick up.) Thank you for your continued support of folks struggling in our communities.

A MESSAGE FROM PASTOR RENÉ L. MEHLBERG...

Dear Beloved Children of God:

"Learning. Leading. Loving."

That is my mantra, motto, or guiding words for this year.

Some of you have heard me talk about these words already. And yes, I wrote about them in the annual reports. However, we often need to hear or read things multiple times before it becomes part of us. So, please read again as some things may be new.

Learning: There is much for me to learn and for you to teach me as I continue to get to know this part of northwestern Minnesota. I'm learning what makes each church and community unique and how those gifts can be used throughout the parish. I'm learning your stories, as you're learning mine. We will learn much from one another. A great way for me to learn is for you to invite me to activities and events or for coffee or a meal.

Leading: I am called to lead and ask God to help me do my best. And, you are leaders as well, in both big and small ways. I know many of you have done some heavy, hard work over the past few years and even for many years (or decades) before. I also recognize and respect leaders needing to take a rest and step away. Leading and leadership can have many different looks. Perhaps we can dream and try new things to see what may work for us now.

Loving: When Jesus was asked what was the greatest commandment, he responded with, "Love the Lord your God with all your heart and all your soul and your mind and love your neighbor as yourself." Love, that is the greatest commandment. Often easy to say while sometimes very difficult to do. Loving means caring for those you have come to know in your churches and communities over the years. Loving means being out in the neighborhood, just as Jesus was. Loving means helping the least of these, as Jesus showed us how to do.

Now, I could add another "L" word…listening. I want to listen to your hopes and dreams, cares and concerns, stories of joy and sorrows, of whatever you want to share. However, three is a holy number, so listening will be part of the learning, leading, and loving.

As we all learn, lead, love, and listen, remember we will stumble along the way. Remember God's forgiveness, grace, love, and mercy that makes us new and allows us to start over once again, as many times as it takes. As I extend it to all of you, I pray you extend it to each other and me as well.

Minutes - A New Journey Parish Council Meeting at Immanuel (January 18, 2023)

The meeting was called to order by President Mike Nelson at 6:08 p.m. Members present - Mike Nelson, Becky Olson, Karen Carlsrud, Jim Steinmetz, Kristi Skeie, Peggy Hanson, Pastor René, Stacey Knudson. Staff - Rachel Roggenbuck, Sue Gunderson. Devotions by Mike.

Secretary's report - a copy passed out - M/S/P - Jim/Kristi to approve the Dec 28, 2022, minutes.

Parish Treasurer report - copies passed out and reviewed. M/S/P - Becky/Peggy to approve.

Go For It Grant - a request from Our Savior's to be reimbursed for the church gettogether on July 13 at McIntosh - taco supper - the amount \$1,250. They will withdraw their request for a sound system, M/S/P - Jim/Karen - to reimburse them the \$1,250 from the Go For It Grant.

Staff report: Pastor René introduced herself - discussed briefly - Learning/Leading/Loving. Installation will be February 5th at 10 a.m at Immanuel/Bejou followed by a potluck meal. Pastor Rebel will preach that Sunday. Discussion on the offering - offering will go to the parish and the council will decide. M/S/P - Stacey/Becky to give 25% of offering that day to Rural Revival.

Lent/Ash Wednesday discussion - Ash Wednesday - place and time yet to be decided. Lenten services will be rotated between the churches. M/S/P - Kristi/Peggy - the host church of Lent will decide where to give the offering.

Pastor René stated to let her know when visiting is required for someone - wants to get out and meet people. Discussion held on the software program - Sundays and Season Deluxe program. M/S/P - Jim/Kristi to approve the yearly subscription of \$429.

President Mike stated the old accounts are closed and balance transferred to ANJLP. We have yet to work on the Constitution for ANJLP.

Discussed the Sundal contracted services. Their balance will be paid back to them less services for November, December and January (pulpit supply/bulletins/newsletter). M/S/P - Kristi/Jim - to charge Sundal \$50 a month for bulletins/newsletter and they will pay for their pulpit supply starting in February.

An update on Pastor René's move - Jim stated it went well - she is living in Mcintosh for January and February - \$500/month. Discussion held on possible locations for future - tabled until February meeting.

Clarification on Pastor René's insurance package - what the amount quoted (\$596) and what is actual (\$948) discussed. M/S/P - Jim/Becky - to cover from the slush fund and adjust for the 2024 budget.

President Mike stated it was 7 p.m. - election of officers still needed to be done, M/S/P - Becky/Kristi to adjourn the meeting and do election of officers at the February meeting. Next meeting - date to be determined.

Lent Begins Ash Wednesday, February 22

We will gather Wednesdays during Lent. On Ash Wednesday, we will try something new with a Noon service at Our Savior's and a 7:00 p.m. at Gary. Watch next month's newsletter for the rest of the schedule.

What is Lent?

Lent marks the forty days leading up to Easter, mirroring the forty days Jesus spent in the wilderness. It is a practice that began during the 4th century as a way to prepare Christians for the holiest days of the year.

During Lent, we ask God to show us the world as it is. We begin with the reality of our finitude rubbed on our foreheads on Ash Wednesday—from dust we were made, to dust we shall return. Then, we walk through that reality in a kind of dress rehearsal. It's the downward slope of God—the Great Descent, where the whole Church walks toward the cross.

A prayer as we start on this year's Lenten journey:

God, on my best days when I feel capable and unwavering, remind me of my dependence on you. And on the days when I feel inside out with inadequacies and anxieties, remind me of your enoughness for today. Though my days and moods and fears and circumstances seem always in flux, you remain. Amen.
