MESSAGE FROM PASTOR RENÉ L. MEHLBERG... "What was Your 2024 Star Words?"

Dear Beloved Children of God:

We are here once again, preparing for the often very full, too busy holiday season. Thanksgiving is upon us with Christmas literally around the corner. With Thanksgiving as late as it can be, the time from one to the other will fly by. Christmas decorations, inside and out, are already out.

Last January, you had the opportunity to choose a "Star Word", a word to guide you, meditate on, remind you of the gifts you have to share or to live into. At the February parish council meeting, I asked people about their star word, not too long from when those words were chosen. Some remembered and others said, "I didn't know there was going to be homework!" It's now December, and I'm asking again...Can you find or remember your word?

My word is "encouragement" with the star being carried in my pencil case all year. I can think how I have encouraged others throughout the year: getting involved, trying new things, cheering on our youth from the sidelines. Sitting with a grieving family after a death and continuing to show up for the time to come. I also receive encouragement from you: trying new things, getting to be a part of the community, seeing how people can come together to accomplish great things!

I "encourage" you to reflect on your word (some may need to find it first) to consider how the Holy Spirit showed up to you through that word in 2024. I've heard a couple stories and would love to hear even more!

This is a combined December-January newsletter, to "encourage" some rest for staff between Christmas and the New Year. I will also "encourage" each of you, in

the midst of the hustle and bustle of so much, to find time to breathe in God's presence, goodness, and love and breathe out any anxieties and worries.

Christmas is the celebration of when God's love came down, in the flesh, as a baby born to unwed teenagers in a stable. That babe grew up to show us how to live and love and be in relationship with one another. It's about love. It's about relationships. Give thanks to God for the special people in your lives and that love that carries us through.

A MESSAGE FROM RACHEL ROGGENBUCK, SAM...

Grace to you and peace from God our Father and our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. Amen.

As we have celebrated our Thanksgiving with family and friends, and set our eyes toward the birth of Jesus and the new year, let us also keep focused on the one who loves us just as we are. The one who picks us up, comforts us and helps us to continue the journey toward Him. Let us share and love as we go.

<u>The Heavenly City</u>. adapted from a Jewish folktale, reminds us of the words of Jesus, "The kingdom of God is not coming with signs to be observed; nor will they say, 'Lo here it is!' or 'There!' for behold, the kingdom of God is in the midst of you" (Luke 17:20-21) In the same way, the vision of peace begins close to us.

There once was a poor man who grew weary of the corruption and hatred that he experienced every day. He was tired of the constant injustice that his people experienced.
